Handheld announces major upgrade of the Algiz 8

The hugely successful tablet PC Algiz 8 from handheld received some major upgrades.

Handheld, the Swedish based supplier of rugged terminals, announces a major upgrade of its successful Algiz 8 tablet PC. The new version of the Algiz 8 will have the new 1,1 GHz ATOM processor from Intel Corporation. Furthermore the optional outdoor readable display will be upgraded to a new screen with an unprecedented quality and brightness of more than 1100 NITs.

There is also an upgrade in size of hard drive, 60 GB instead of 40 GB and there will also be an option for solid state flash disc instead of rotating hard drive. The standard RAM memory is increased to 1 GB instead of 512 MB.
